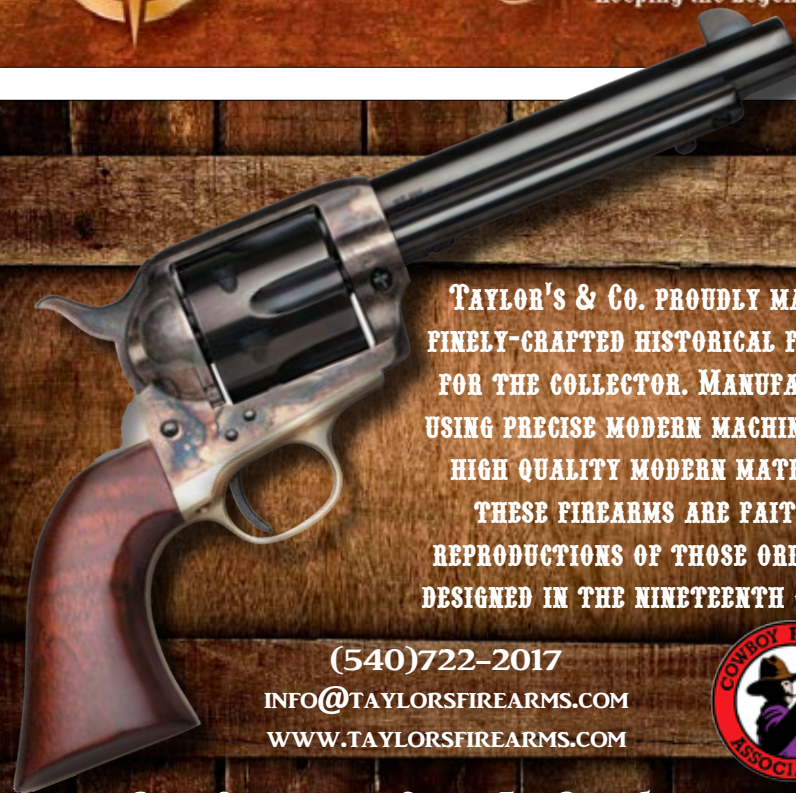

INSIDE THE CFDA

As our 2021 Cowboy Fast Draw Season continues, I'm pleased to report that our attendance numbers at most of our CFDA Titled Championships have exceeded expectations! I would like to take this opportunity to THANK all of our CFDA Host Clubs for all that they do, as they continue planning and putting on the best events they can for our members to enjoy! There is a lot to learn about putting on a successful CFDA Titled Championship, but most of all, it takes planning, dedication, and vision. But, I'll get into that a little later in this column...

New Members & Discovering our CFDA Family

As our members first get involved in our sport, they first must gather their personal equipment like a good six-gun, holster, and other accessories. If they are fortunate enough to have a CFDA Affiliated Club nearby they have a huge advantage over someone who lives many miles away from one. Even if the nearest club is hours of driving away, it is important to plan a trip to visit them, since they can help a new member get started in so many ways.

I firmly believe that once a member actually travels to and competes in a CFDA Titled Championship, that is the point that they will either fall in love with our sport and become a dedicated member or not. For it is only there, that they can discover and get to know some of our network of great people we are fortunate to have in CFDA. We call it, "Our CFDA Family", for a reason. That reason is a "Bond of Mutual Respect" that we share.

You see, a lot of folks get involved with Cowboy Fast Draw and find out that they can get "pretty good" in our sport in a relatively short amount of time. Quite a few folks can get into the 5's or 6's quite quickly and can soon place fairly high in the standings at some major tournaments, as long as they are hitting consistently. Many find great enjoyment just continuing to shoot tournaments at that speed while making great friends, having fun, and just doing the best that they can. Then, there are those who progress through more dedicated practice and improve to shoot times in 1/2 second or better range with consistency, these members can place extremely high in major tournaments and can come close or even win major titles. Beyond, that are those who push on to shooting in the low 4's and high 3's, and just a few can even attain sub-35's.

So, what do I mean when I use the term "Bond of Mutual Respect"? For something that seems so simple to a casual observer as standing behind a firing line, reacting to a start light, drawing and cocking a six-gun, and hitting a 17" target 15' away with a wax bullet, it can quickly grow into one of the most frustrating and challenging sports you have ever tried. The truth is, that only those of us who get involved with Cowboy Fast Draw can really understand just how hard and challenging our unique sport actually is. Our seasoned members know, THIS IS A HARD GAME, and we respect one another because of it, and it really doesn't matter how fast we are. Just the fact that we are called to the line over a public address system, do the best we can to hit our target under competitive pressure earns you the respect of your peers, along with being graceful whether in defeat or victory. That is known as the CFDA Gunfighter's Bond. Which is why Cowboy Fast Draw is not a "clicky sport" like some I've encountered.

We can all really admire and appreciate our best shooters when they are in their finest competitive form, especially when shooting for a CFDA Titled Championship. We Gunfighters also make the best spectators when it comes to the finals, even though we may have not shot our best to make the finals ourselves. We, more than anyone else, appreciate the real deal when we see it! It is so important that we stay and watch the finals and clap for our champions, just as they would do for us. Many of us work or have to get home for a reason and we respect that too, but we all notice and appreciate when our members make their plans to stick around when possible.

That is what the CFDA Family really is, we make life-long friendships here. I am so proud to be associated with all of you, and is pretty much the same wherever Cowboy Fast Draw exists. Our Motto: Safety First, Fun Second and Competition Third perfectly describes who we are. All 3 of these principles must co-exist to make CFDA the organization it is. Even though competition is third, it is still very important. It is what drives us to improve ourselves in all parts of our lives. America would not have become the great nation it is without competition and CFDA would not exist.

How to Put on a Successful CFDA Event?

Over a decade ago, Mongo and I co-authored an article named "Putting on a Successful CFDA Event". It is still posted on our website. We have learned so much since then, it is perhaps time to write an up to date detailed article.

However, there is one thing that has not changed. Which is the reason I separated the subject of my opening paragraph with the second subject about discovering our CFDA Family.

You must travel to several major tournaments and fall in love with and become dedicated to our sport. If you become truly inspired, you will want to help your club become even better or form a club if you are not lucky enough to be near one. Your club might desire to host a CFDA Titled Event. For that, you will need to gain experience while learning what works and what doesn't by studying how other Host Clubs run their events. You may even think of ways to improve upon what you have learned from others. While fresh ideas are always welcome, we also understand that there are reasons why we have learned to do what we currently do.

One of the best things to know is that the CFDA Family will not let you down. The majority of our members will show up with the spirit to help wherever needed. Among a Host Club's biggest challenges are finding a great venue, sponsors, providing motel information, and acquiring the necessary ranges and equipment to conduct their tournament. Once your event is set up and ready to run, our CFDA Family will offer to Announce, Range Master, and fill out Score Sheets, as we actually enjoy forming a posse to help our fellow shooters complete a round on the range we are assigned.

Of utmost importance is to make sure that you have a competent and experienced Score Keeping Team that understands the CFDA Scoring Program and has not only practiced running club matches, but has also received instruction and perhaps some experience in running large matches.

Also, good to know, is that there is a system of clubs and CFDA Regulators around who are there for support in so many ways that you cannot imagine. They might be able to be in a position of lend Timers, P.A. Systems, Audience Displays, CFDA Brass, Ammo Boxes & Stands, and even Backstops. Please don't hesitate to ask for help and advice. We all want your event to succeed.

Triple 7 Challenge

In 2014, we conducted several tests at various CFDA Events with the best shooters in the sport of that era. The data established with these tests caused me to author the CFDA Triple 7 Test article, which can still be found on our website in the Rules Section. This article explains the scientific data that was used as the basis for establishing Procedural Violation #3. on page 35. of our current rulebook that states that no backup attempts will be considered for any shot recorded under a .275 @ 21' or .267 @ 15'. Of course, this was disputed by several self-described experts. The original article did acknowledge that someone might exist that possesses extraordinary hand speed or reactions

and as stated in PV #3, "Any CFDA Member may request an official Triple 7 Test."

Here it is 7 years later, no one to my knowledge has requested an official Triple 7 Test. Since the previous test results were used as scientific data to create an actual rule, it is perhaps time to update our data since we have so many new members with great talent. True science is based only upon facts and should always be open to updated data.

So, I am proposing a challenge to be carried out at this year's Fastest Gun Alive on Thursday. Since the original test used a 24" target, so shall this test. It's called Triple 7 because it is done at 7 feet, firing 7 shots that just record reactions (included is hammer-drop time a.k.a. lock-time and wax bullet travel time for 7 feet), and 7 shots fired from the holster as fast as you can hit the target, while following CFDA Rules. We will even lower the target to 43" due to this being the proportional height if the target were at 21', which we did not do in the original test.

Members may take this test at no charge, we will provide shotgun primer loads. The current rule states that if a shot faster than .275 is fired at 21', that it is considered an automatic anticipation and cannot be backed up. Therefore, if we deduct .02 which is the difference between a wax bullet traveling at 7' as opposed to 21', that would make a comparable shot at a .255 @ 7'..

Those taking the test can only take it one time, unless a confirmation re-test is required, and their fastest time in each 7 shot series must be backed up within 1 hundredth of a second (.01).

Reward: If a CFDA Member can successfully fire a backed up shot faster than .255 at 7', then they shall earn a reward of \$100 per thousandths of a second, up to \$1,000!

Notes: We reserve the right to pay only the fastest successful challenge, if two shooters tie, they shall split the Reward. Since this data may be used to potentially modify our current rule, we may require a re-test to confirm new data, but it will not affect the above stated reward. The shooters must complete both sets of 7 shots to qualify, as the reaction data is used also in determining this rule.

In Closing

We hope to see you at the FGA! At the time of this writing we are at about 200 Entries with many more expected, our maximum number is 330 Contestants. Let's make this one the best FGA ever, to end our 2021 Season!

Caldwell, Idaho - Bright sunshine but a cool breeze welcomed shooters to the opening day of the 12th Annual Great Northwest Territorial Championship at the Crazy Woman Range hosted by the Snake River Gunslingers. First up were the category matches with 67 registered shooters. Congratulations to our winners: Emberly (Annie Oakley); Silent Shot (Billy the Kid); Chaos Cass (Junior Girl); Exile (Junior Boy); Sassie Cowgirl and Crosswired (Traditional); Miss B Haven and Tin Bender (49'r); Ms. Hettie and Half Fast Eddie (Senior); Ricochet Rose and Red Ryder (Super Senior); Legally Loaded (Grand Dame); Old Drifter (Old Timers); Stanislaus (Golden Gun); Sundowner (Elder Statesman); and Sagebrush Sal and Gambler (Shootist).

The weather steadily improved as Saturday morning dawned bright and clear (and a little less breezy) for the main match. We welcomed 22 ladies and 60 men representing the states of Idaho, Oregon, Washington, Nevada, Utah, California and Texas. After the Pledge, National Anthem and presentation of the category awards, Legally Loaded and PG Taylor honored all our veterans who we are so privileged to share our sport with. Each was presented with a slim pocket knife engraved with GNTC. After a brief safety meeting, PG Taylor sent everyone on their way for the first round. With

Wild Shot in the Schoolhouse entering and running score sheets, we were able to wrap up for the day by midafternoon.

Bounty Hunter and Legally Loaded provided dinner at the range Friday evening and Saturday evening's dinner was provided by the Snake River Gunslingers along with Bounty Hunter and Legally Loaded. An impromptu poker game after Saturday's dinner raised \$600 for Shoot for the Stars. Also, that evening we received the sad news that Francis Carlos, aka The Draw, had passed away. Many shooters have known The Draw for many years and

have lots of fond memories and others of us, myself included, have only met him a few times. For myself, my favorite memory of The Draw is when he and Old West vied for the 2019 GNTC Men's Championship. It was a very entertaining final with these two Golden Guns. Old West came out on top and The Draw placed second.

Shooting began bright and early on Sunday morning with the Shoot for Loot bracket matches. Congratulations to our winners:

The main match then resumed as we worked our way down to the top seven men and ladies. Prior to beginning the finals, a live auction was held for a John Wayne picture made and donated by Ricochet and Trinidad's dispatcher; a Navajo made coral jewelry set consisting of a necklace, earrings and bracelet; and a knife with sheath and stand made and donated by Desert Dingo. The winning bids went to Crosswired (John Wayne picture), Quick Cal (jewelry set) and Ol Buck'r (knife). After winning the bid for the jewelry, Quick Cal promptly presented the set to his granddaughter, Little Miss Sunshine. GNTC was able to donate \$700 to Shoot for the Stars with proceeds from the poker game and silent and live auctions.

First to take center stage in the finals were our lady shooters. The finals featured Legally Loaded seeded seventh (ID), Lady Hawk sixth (ID), Miss B Haven fifth (ID), Huckleberry Honey fourth (CA), Little Miss Sunshine third (NV), Debbie Sioux second (ID) and KK Kid first (TX). After it was





all sorted out, Lady Hawk placed seventh, Huckleberry Honey sixth, and Little Miss Sunshine fifth. Legally Loaded worked her way from seventh seed to place fourth and Debbie Sioux placed third. That left Miss B Haven and KK Kid to shoot it out for the championship with KK Kid being crowned the 2021 GNTC Ladies Champion!

Next up were our youth shooters. Emberly from Idaho placed first, Anytime Kid from California came in second and Silent Shot from Idaho was third. Emberly claimed the Annie Oakley championship and Anytime Kid the Billy the Kid title. Emberly is a member of a brand-new club in north Idaho, the Treaty Rock Freedom Fighters. This was the first major match for Emberly along with her dad, HooDoo Shooter, and grandpa, Selkirk Rambler. We welcome them to the CFDA!

Our Junior Girls featured Chaos Cass (OR), Shell Shock (TX) and Little Miss Sunshine (NV). Chaos Cass placed first with Shell Shock following in second and Little Miss Sunshine third. In the Junior Boys, Tank from Idaho placed first, Iron Will from Oregon second and Exile from Idaho third.

The top seven seeded men (from seventh to first) were Cody (ID), Taz (CA), Crosswired (OR), Dangerous Dave (ID), Tin Bender (ID), Desert Dingo (UT) and Tank (ID). Keeping it in the family as grandson and grandpa, Tank and Tin Bender were left to shoot for the championship with Tin Bender placing second and Tank emerging as the 2021

GNTC Men's Champion! Crosswired followed in third place, Desert Dingo fourth, Dangerous Dave fifth, Taz sixth and Cody seventh.

The Top Couple award went to Legally Loaded and Bounty Hunter. Our GNTC Resident Champions are Debbie Sioux and Tin Bender. Awards for first out of the match went to Cardoza Kid for the ladies and Crazy Horse for the men. Spirit of the Game was awarded to Sandy of the Snake River Gunslingers.

Throughout the match, raffle tickets were sold for one of the firearms donated by CFDA and the lucky winner was Nessuno. All registered shooters were eligible for the second firearm donated by CFDA, which was won by Tallahassee, our event photographer extraordinaire!

A special thanks to Wild Shot who kept the scoring humming along in the Schoolhouse and a thank you, too, to all those who volunteered to range master, announce and help keep score. Thank you to PG Taylor, Legally Loaded and the members of the Snake River Gunslingers for hosting this year's event. And last but not least, thank you to everyone who attended and competed in the 2021 GNTC. Again, congratulations to all our winners! Next up at the Crazy Woman Range is the Idaho State Championship, hosted by the Sawtooth Shootist Society, September 3-5, 2021. Be sure and mark your calendars for May 27-29, 2022 for the 13th Annual Great Northwest Territorial Championship.

Recipes of the Old West - Blotta Lead's Famous Soupy Chicken

Who doesn't love chicken recipes and the delicious dishes they create? This is one of our family favorites, especially Quick Cal's. Served over a bed of wide egg noodles, a pile of rice, or a big scoop of mashed potatoes, it's the best ever on a cold winter evening!

I'm not a professional recipe writer but I'll do my best to give you the particulars on how to "cook it up"!

To get started:

1. In a pie pan or something to dredge the chicken in, put the flour and the three seasonings in the pan and mix up until well blended. Set aside.

2. Prep chicken, roll in the flour mixture so it's all pieces are well coated. Set aside.

In a large skillet (with a lid) or Dutch oven (with a heavy lid), pour about 1/4 cup of oil in the bottom, not too much, and let it heat up so your chicken will fry evenly and get a nice golden crust on it. You don't need to cook it all the way through as the final cooking time, either in the oven or on the stove top will finish the job.

3. Once the chicken is precooked with a nice golden tone to it, set it aside. You'll notice you'll have a bit of oil and all the brown chicken goodies on the bottom, don't discard this, just scrap

them around to free it from the bottom of the frying pan or your Dutch oven pot. Next, with all the goodies on the bottom of your pan, throw in the onion, mushrooms and bell peppers, stir them around a bit, throw in the cans of stewed tomatoes, brown sugar, (to taste for sure- start with a smaller amount and go more if you need to), the packet of onion soup, a bit of the seasoning (to taste of course) stir it around some more, and as it gets cooking, put in a tablespoon or two of the flour mixture, stir it around to make a medium thin roué, add chicken stock to thin the gravy out to however thin or thick you like. We like a thinner gravy, it's not so heavy feeling. Once you get all your main ingredients into the cooking vessel, stir it around to the consistency you want for the gravy, add the chicken back to the pan, puddling it down into the gravy. *Yummm, just thinking about it makes me hungry!* Anyway, with a good heavy lid covering your pan or pot, this wonderful dish needs to cook on your stove top at a low- medium to medium heat, making sure it's not going to burn for at least an hour, or in the oven at 350 degrees for a good hour and a half. Chicken needs to be cooked thoroughly, but when you lift the lid and the amazing aroma hits you in the face from everything cooking together, you'll need to have your pile of egg noodles or mashed potatoes ready on the plate to place a piece of chicken or two on top, with the gravy from heaven gently being spooned over the top of it all.....oh my goodness, I'm trying to get through this without going out and buying chicken for tonight's dinner.... But with a side salad and warm slices of sourdough bread drenched in butter and honey mixture....holy cow.....I can't take it anymore! Well, just make it once and you'll know exactly what I'm drooling over! Enjoy!

Footnote**** 40 years ago I didn't have a recipe for this, I just started throwing this and that in the pot and boom! Soupy Chicken!

You'll need:

- Large chicken breast – 4 (Four) of them works great or 6-8 chicken thighs. Cut some of the fat off.
- Large Onion cut in half and quartered - 1
- Large Green Bell Pepper or Red, or both, cut in strips -1
- Cup of sliced Mushrooms
- Packet of onion soup mix
- Cup of flour for coating and a bit for thickening the gravy
- Brown Sugar- 1/4 cup if you like it a bit sweeter, a bit more does the job. Less sugar, less sweet. Go by taste
- Large cans of Italian stewed Tomatoes – 2 of them does the trick
- Chicken Stock – about 2-3 cups to start, more if you like a thinner gravy
- Oil for Cooking
- Salt, pepper, and a good shake of garlic seasoning all to taste

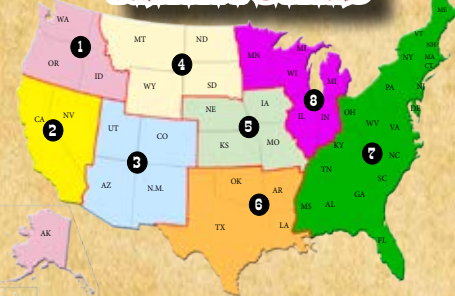

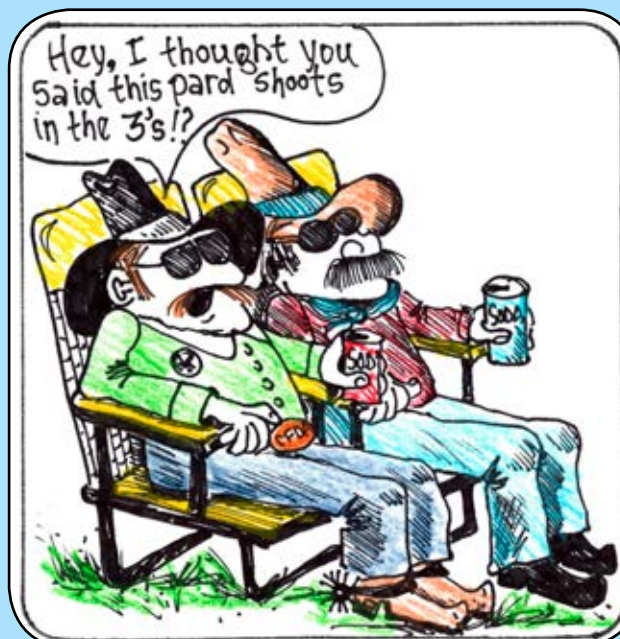
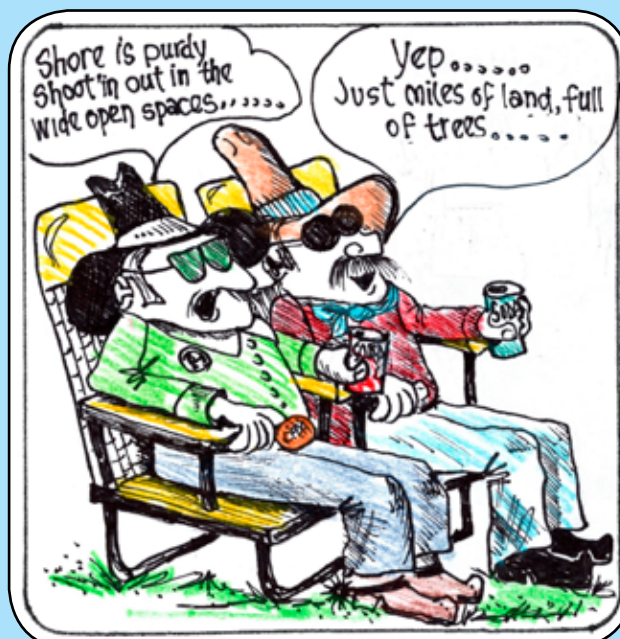

That ol bull did his job like the cowboy on top, you know it was one hell of a ride.

But the bull wasn't finished so he spun around and headed the cowboy's way.

Ned Christie

“ INDIAN OUTLAW OR CHEROKEE PATRIOT “ THE TRUE STORY OF HOW NED CHRISTIE DIED

For those readers, and hope there are some readers, that don't know Ned Christie was a Cherokee Indian in Eastern Oklahoma Indian Territory. He had been accused of many crimes and had been sought after and pursued by many US Marshals. The Marshals operated out of Ft. Smith Arkansas under the command of Judge Issac Parker, you've heard of him, he was affectionately known as the "Hanging Judge".

The Marshal had been chasing Ned for several years but in 1892 it all came to an end.

US Deputy Marshals lead by the famous Heck Thomas made their way from Ft. Smith to Ned Christies fortress outside of Tahlaquah, Oklahoma Indian Territory. When I say fortress thats what I mean. The building had double thick walls with sand between them. Ned knew they wanted him and he wasn't going to give up without a fight. He had cleared all trees and brush from around the house-fortess so any aggressor could not find cover. On the night the 16 Deputies showed up, they surrounded the fortress and one of the Deputies was 23 year old James Wesley "Wes" Bowman. He was positioned to the front of the fortress. When morning light came Ned Christie was ordered to surrender. His answer was several guns shots which the Marshals answered. None of which seem to hit a mark. Finally the Marshals brought out the BIG GUN. It was a cannon they had brought from Ft. Smith. They began firing at the building but the cannon balls bounced off the wall and flew back at the Deputies. This whole operation seemed to be not working until one of the Deputies Charley Copeland ran with a bundle of dynamite with the fuse lit and shoved it under the corner of the house-fortress. The explosion demolished part of the house and fire from the fireplace did the rest. Ned Christie came running out of the house firing his Winchester 1873. With uncertain light and smoke Ned was mistaken for a US Marshal until he almost collided with Wes Bowman. Both men turned and fired, Christie missed but the blast from his muzzle left powder burns on young Wes Bowman's face. Wes didn't miss and he ended the outlaw career of Ned Christie.

Many Historians might disagree with this account. Most Cherokees say Ned was out of bullets and was just gunned down by the law. The Cherokee people call Ned Christie a patriot and one who was mistreated by white folks. All I have to say about that is maybe he was. There has never been any hard facts that Ned was a criminal. But what is fact is he wasn't out of bullets. The reason I know this is because one of my best friends in life, Paul Bowman, is Wes Bowman's grandson. The story was told to Paul by his Grandfather many times and Paul still can remember seeing the powder burn scar on his Grandfather's face.

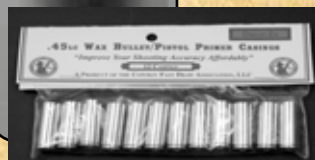

Cowboy Fast Draw Association holds a Federal Firearms License (FFL). We only ship (usually USPS) and transfer firearms to other FFL Dealers, which costs \$30 per gun. It is up to the purchaser to choose their FFL Dealer and instruct them to FAX (775) 575-5748 or email (info@cowboyfastdraw.com) a copy of their FFL to us. After receiving payment we will then ship the firearm to your FFL Dealer, who will then be responsible to have you fill out the appropriate forms and conduct a background check, according to Federal and your State Laws and Regulations.

The buyer is responsible to pay all transfer fees, background checks directly to their FFL Dealer of choice.

All Firearm Sales Are Final. In the unlikely event that your FFL Dealer cannot process your transfer paperwork due to a background check that did not pass. The buyer may contact our office and request a return of the firearm and a refund of the sale. The gun must be returned to CFDA only by the FFL Dealer that it was originally sent to, in the original condition. The Guns

Single-action revolvers, factory chambered for .45 Colt caliber, with non-adjustable rear sights such as: SAA Colt, Colt Bisley, 1858 Remington conversions, 1875 Remington, S&W Schofield and faithful reproductions thereof, plus most Ruger Vaquero models. The external parts of the revolver must match factory stock contours and made of original type material: i.e. hammers must not be bent in any way. No trigger shoes, no mods to the trigger guard or grip frame, etc. Front sights are optional and barrels must be a minimum length of 4-1/2", except in the Shootist Category (7-1/2"). Hammer knurling may be smoothed.

The Holsters & Gun Belts

1800's-style Mexican Loop, Slim Jim, and California Pattern holsters or leather rawhide construction. The over the belt-style holster will be worn on the side of the leg only. No cross-draw, shoulder, buscadero, contemporary Hollywood or steel lined holsters are allowed.

Ammunition

95% of ammunition used in Cowboy Fast Draw is .45 colt casings that are specially modified to accept 209 shotgun primers and no gun powder. Velocities reach about 650 fps. Only in major competitions Cowboy Fast Draw Cartridges are used, they must be loaded by CFDA approved reloaders.

Targets (Three Standard Targets)

24" Round Plate 50" Height to Center - Start Light in Center
17-3/16" Rnd Plate 47" Height to Center - Start Light in Center
17-3/4" Balloon-Disc 47" Height to Center - See Specs
White lithium grease is applied to target plates, to track all wax bullet hits.

Competition Timers

Digital timers must time to the thousandth of a second. Synchronized contests must use target with impact sensors.

Shooting Style

Most folks use a thumb-cocking method, but fanning is allowed. Trigger finger must be out of the trigger guard. If used to cock the hammer the off-hand must not be placed in front of the body before the start light comes on.

Contests

Contests are shot elimination style, best 2 out of 3, or 3 out of 5 shots per round. The standard contest is luck of the draw man vs. man elimination.

1800's period clothing is strongly recommended. Western cowboy, including working cowboy clothing is acceptable. Western boots or moccasins are acceptable footwear. Western-style blue and black jeans are acceptable. Victorian Steampunk is also allowed.

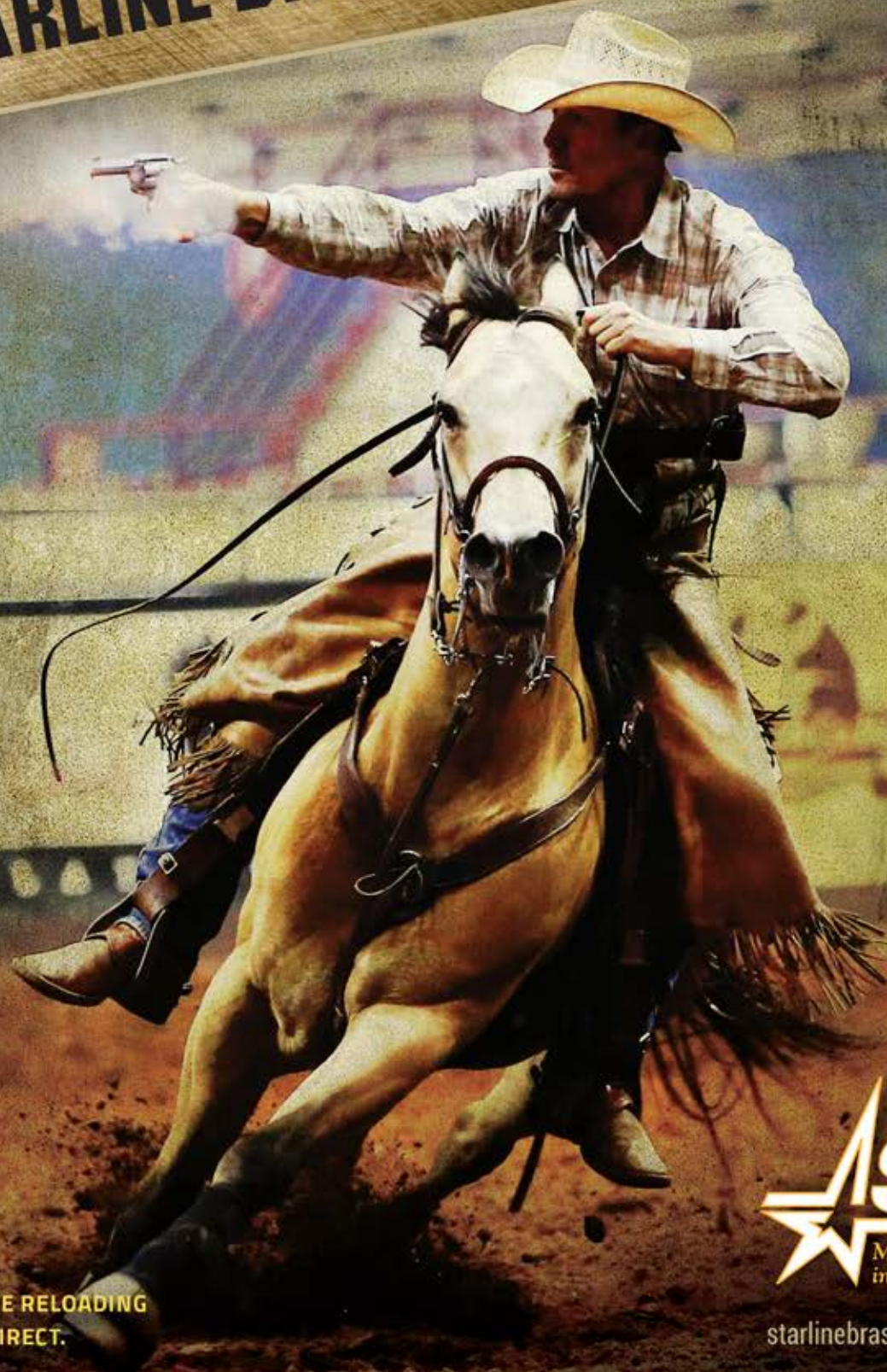
